Dear Parents and Guardians:

Hello everyone! I am the school social worker Ms Yung, I am very pleased to be part of the family at Chu Lee Yuet Wah. I will be at your service on Monday and Thursday from 8.45 am to 5.30pm providing consultation and support.

My duty is to observe the children behaviour and emotion, working closely with parents and the school to gather all information then set up individual meetings and group activities which best suit their development and needs.

We design many different fun activities, such as storytelling, drawing and games, so that the children will learn through play and learn how to express their feelings. We guide them to enhance their ability in positive thinking and to have problem solving skills which promotes a friendly and harmonious school life.

The school social workers group will provide consultation and support services to parents and guardians. We hope through various activities such as workshops, group discussions and parent-child activities we can offer further support from the parent's point of view; to help and set up individual learning plans with a rewarding system and follow up each case.

Please contact us through the school staff if you have any queries. We would like to share some experiences, hoping this will help you. Let's all try and foster our children's growth together.

When a child is frustrated and has a tantrum when they cannot have an item, what should the parent do?

Parents should not be affected by the child's emotions at that moment. Instead, you should be patient and wait until they calm down then take them to quite place and explain to them why they weren't given the item. Explain to them having a tantrum is not the proper way and teach them how to express their feelings positively. Parent should follow this through with the principal.



To help children to apply positive thinking in daily situations and develop their ability to express their feelings and practice their fundamental skills in a positive way ...

Objectives

- Through different designed activities to develop their understanding of positive education.
- Enhance their ability to use positive thinking to apply knowledge and skills effectively and appropriately in their daily life.
- To provide an opportunity such as workshops for quality time and for parents to better understand their children and to experience how to nurture children to develop good character.

Program Content

For Parent

- Increase understanding of how to handle and teach a child facing challenges positively in daily life.
- Through our workshop to introduce this year's program to help parents understand the meaning and objectives and understand positive education.
 Through the designed activities to practice on how to handle a child's negative emotions and behaviours.

For Child

To help children learn to be positive and optimistic and develop a grateful and cherished character and problem-solving skill.

- Learning through 10 positive fruit (Positive feelings, Appreciation, Optimistic, Caring, Perseverance, Connection, Perception, Creativity, Concentration, Resilience) to develop their abilities in different areas.
- Learn through story and role-playing activities for children to understand different emotions and provide positive educational activities to help and develop their problem-solving skills.
- Provide a notice board for children to use for wording or pictures to express and share their feelings.
- Praise Time: Teacher will read out the praise card to praise the child.
- Social worker will lead a small group for emotional activities, provide opportunities
 for children to have meaningful practices, learn how to express their feelings and
 being positive and optimistic.

Introduce Po Leung Little Angel Program

 To promote kindness and caring for each other, where the older children will be role models for caring and helping their younger classmates at school.

Introduce Little Assistant Program

 To build children's self confidence and learn to be optimistic, teacher will encourage and assign children to assist with some simple tasks.




