Service Standard Overview

- Standard 9: The service unit will take all necessary measures to provide a safe environment for all service users.
- Standard 10: The service unit to ensure the service users is provided with the information on how to apply and withdraw from the service.
- Standard 11: The service unit should have a planned program with effective assessment and review to meet the needs of the service users (No matter the service users are individual, family, groups or community).
- Standard 12: The service unit tries its best to respect the right of service users to make informed service choices.
- Standard 13: The service unit should respect the private property right of the service users.
- Standard 14: The service unit should respect and protect the right of privacy and confidentiality of the service users.
- Standard 15: The service should take all necessary measures to ensure that service users are protected from infringement.
- Standard 16: Every service user and staff has the right to file complaints or express their dissatisfaction without worrying about being punished, and the filed complaint will be addressed properly.

For Parents

Snacks Recommendations - Cat rice cake

Ingredients :

Rice cakes(round shape) 、 Strawberries 、 Bananas 、 Dry blue berries 、 raisin 、 white bread 、 peanut butter

Steps :

1. Clean the strawberries and cut in slices.
2. Peel the bananas and cut in slices and 1 in triangle shape.
3. Cut the white bread in stripes and put peanut butter to stick them on the rice cake.
4. Put strawberry slice as the ears, blue berries as eyes, raisin as nose, bananas as cheek and the triangle banana as mouth and bread as whiskies.
